# 1715 Nelson Ave. HDFC Completes Weatherization



On December 6, 2010, 1715 Nelson Ave. HDFC in the Bronx became the first building to become fully weatherized through UHAB's Weatherization Assistance Program (WAP). The grant, which is part of an energy efficiency and conservation program administered by New York State Homes and Community Renewal and the U.S. Department of Energy, covers a wide array of energy fixes in HDFCs.

Once 1715 Nelson qualified for the program, the UHAB

Weatherization team worked with the Community Environmental Center to produce an energy audit that determined the scope of work to be covered by the grant. And now, with two months of construction completed, the residents of 1715 Nelson have a much more efficient building: both in terms of energy use and monetary savings.

1715 Nelson first underwent pipe and boiler insulation, roof insulation, and a series of improvements to vents and valves. Then, each unit had brand new windows installed, as well as new energy star refrigerators. Compact fluorescent lights were also put in to replace all the lights in each unit, as well as those in the hallways and common spaces.

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With all these new improvements, the board and residents of 1715 Nelson are extremely excited. "The process has been going nice and smooth. The window guys were good, the
